Nairobi-Mt Kenya-Samburu-Baringo-Bogoria-Nakuru-Mara - 9 days 8 nights

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Day 1 - Nairobi > Mt Kenya

It is an early departure from Nairobi, about a 3 hour drive to Nanyuki. We arrive in time for lunch at William Holden's former home, Mt. Kenya Safari Club. An afternoon of relaxation by the pool until sunset and dinner. Overnight and Dinner Mt Kenya Safari Club.
Optional: Visit to the orphanage or horse riding on the slopes of Mt. Kenya.

Day 2 - Mt Kenya > Samburu National Reserve

The journey this morning will take approximately 2 hours before entering Samburu National Reserve at Archers Post arriving at the lodge in time for lunch. Afternoon game drive along the Ewaso Ngiro river, magically fringed by majestic doum palms.
Dinner and overnight Samburu Game Lodge or similar.

Day 3 - Samburu National Reserve

We will spend a full day in the Samburu Game Reserve searching for the big five and observing the vast unspoiled scenery during morning and afternoon game drives. The park is plentiful with crocodiles that bask on muddy riverbanks and velvet monkeys that frolic in the late afternoon sun.
Dinner & Overnight Samburu Game Lodge.

Day 4 - Samburu National Reserve > Lake Baringo

We depart Samburu after breakfast and drive north to Wamba, then Maralal, before heading south back to Baringo. A short boat ride will take us to Island Camp. Here lunch awaits us. This afternoon we can relax by the pool on top of the island with an incredible 180° panoramic view of the lake. In the late afternoon as the heat of the day decreases we will take a boat ride to explore the shores of the lake hoping to catch a glimpse of an African Eagle swooping on its prey in the magical evening light. And we may see crocodiles too, basking on the lakeshore.
Dinner and overnight Island Camp.



Day 5 - Lake Bogoria National Reserve

After an early breakfast, we head off with a picnic lunch to explore Lake Bogoria National Reserve. Like Lake Baringo and Lake Nakuru, this lake lies in the Great Rift Valley. An alkaline lake, it is home to large flocks of flamingos, which feast on the blue-green algae. Birds of more than 100 other species, including the Yellow-billed Stork and the African Spoonbill are found on the lake which is famous for its geothermically active geysers and hot springs. Dinner and Overnight Island Camp or Similar,

Day 6 - Lake Baringo > Nakuru National Park

A morning drive will take us to Lake Nakuru, famous for its spectacular birdlife: flamingos, pelicans, cormorants, herons, grebes, birds of prey, a veritable paradise for ornithologists. Lake Nakuru is also renowned for its large mammals: rhinoceroses both black and white, african buffaloes and rothschild's giraffe. Lions and leopards are often seen. Large troops of olive baboons wander about the cliffs towering the park. Dinner and overnight Sarova Lion Hill or Similar.

Day 7 - Nakuru National Park > Masai Mara National Park

A drive over the Mau escarpment to the bustling Masai capital of Narok, and then on to the vast plains and rolling hills of the Mara, arriving to the lodge in time for lunch. Each year, between June and November, hundreds of thousands of wildebeest and zebras from the southern plains in the Serengeti come to the northern plains of the Masai Mara in search of pasture. This is always a thrilling spectacle. Dinner and overnight Mara Serena or Similar.

Day 8 - Masai Mara National Reserve

Dawn. Freshly brewed coffee. We're off on our first early morning game drive. There's a sharp chill in the air. Wrapped in your Masai blanket, you'll see the animals emerging from the mist between the acacia thickets. The thought of bacon and fried eggs will draw us back to the lodge for breakfast. The day then begins to warm up, as we go out to explore the magic of the Mara's different ecosystems. Lunch. Relax. Then, out again until sunset. This stunning savannah is a paradise for herbivore diversity. You'll see them all: Thomson's gazelles, Kongoni, Topi... And you'll see the predators as well: lions and cheetahs! We may even find these big cats on a kill. Then back to the lodge. We'll enjoy sundowners around the campfire before dinner. Lala salama! Dinner and overnight Mara Serena or similar.
