KENYA TANZANIA ROAD SAFARI
Nairobi-Samburu-Nakuru-Mara-Serengeti-Ngorongoro-Arusha 10 days 9 nights

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Day 1 - Nairobi > Samburu National Reserve +310km +6h

The journey this morning will take us past tea, coffee and pineapple estates as well as small scale farmers subsiding on mixed crops of coffee that they can sell to a cooperative and maize and other products for their daily consumptions. We will arrive to the lodge in time for lunch. Afternoon game drive along the Ewaso Ngiro river, magically fringed by majestic doum palms. Dinner and overnight Samburu Game Lodge or similar.

Day 2 - Samburu National Reserve

We will spend a full day in the Samburu Game Reserve searching for the big five and observing the vast unspoiled scenery during morning and afternoon game drives. The park is plentiful with crocodiles that bask on muddy riverbanks and velvet monkeys that frolic in the late afternoon sun. Dinner & Overnight Samburu Game Lodge.

Day 3 - Samburu > Nakuru National Park +290km +6h

We will drive to Lake Nakuru, famous for its spectacular birdlife: flamingos, pelicans, cormorants, herons, grebes, birds of prey, a veritable paradise for ornithologists. Lake Nakuru is also renown for its large mammals: rhinoceroses both black and white, african buffaloes and rothschild's giraffe. Lions and leopards are often seen. Large troops of olive baboons wander about the cliffs towering the park.

Afternoon game drive & dinner and overnight Sarova Lion Hill or Similar.

Day 4 - Nakuru National Park > Masai Mara National Park +240km +5h

A drive over the Mau escarpment to the bustling Masai capital of Narok, and then on to the vast plains and rolling hills of the Mara, arriving to the lodge in time for lunch. Each year, between June and November, hundreds of thousands of wildebeest and zebras from the southern plains in the Serengeti come to the northern plains of the Masai Mara in search of pasture. This is always a thrilling spectacle.

Afternoon game drive & dinner and overnight Mara Serena or Similar.

Day 5 - Masai Mara National Reserve

Dawn. Freshly brewed coffee. We're off on our first early morning game drive. There's a sharp chill in the air. Wrapped in your Masai blanket, you'll see the animals emerging from the mist between the acacia thickets. The thought of bacon and fried eggs will draw us back to the lodge for breakfast. The day then begins to warm up, as we go out to explore the magic of the Mara's different ecosystems. Lunch. Relax. Then, out again until sunset. This stunning savannah is a paradise for herbivore diversity. You'll see them all: Thomson's gazelles, Kongoni, Topi... And you'll see the predators as well: lions and cheetahs! We may even find these big cats on a kill. Then back to the lodge. We'll enjoy sundowners around the campfire before dinner. Lala salama! Dinner and overnight Mara Serena or similar.

Day 6 - Masai Mara

June, depending on the rains, the advance herds of wildebeests might be arriving to the open plains of the Mara. Today we will take a picnic lunch so as to be independent and spend the day in search of lions on a kill or a wake of vultures feeding on a carcass or simply observing wildlife and the insolide moments they bring on daily basis.

Dinner and overnight Mara Serena or similar.



Day 7 - Mara > Serengeti National Park 285km Approx 6h

This morning we leave the Mara Triangle and drive up the Oolololo escarpment to Lolgorien and on to Isibania border. Here you will say goodbye to your driver guide and after immigration formalities meet your new Tanzanian team for the remaining part of your safari, arriving at the lodge for late lunch.

Afternoon game drive and overnight Seronera Wildlife Lodge or similar.

Day 8 - Serengeti National Park

At this time of the year, June and depending on the rain, usually the migration is on the Western Corridor getting ready to cross the Grumeti River. This is dry season and a good time of the year to see the migration heading to its peak against stunning landscapes.

All day game drive and overnight Seronera Wildlife Lodge or similar.



Day 9 - Serengeti National Park > Ngorongoro Crater +-190km +-4h

Early morning game drive and back to the lodge for breakfast. You can now take a little time to chill by the pool or if keen go out again for a small game drive before an early lunch and depart for Ngorongoro. Before starting our ascend to the crater we will take time to visit Olduvai Gorge, a pre-historic archeological site also known as the Cradle of Mankind. The Ngorongoro Conservation Area is an important example of where people and wildlife can live in harmony. We are in Masai country. Sundowners overlooking this incredible caldera.

Dinner and overnight Ngorongoro Wildlife Lodge or similar.

Day 10 - Ngorongoro > Arusha +190km +- 4h

Early morning breakfast before descending some 600m into the crater for our last game drive in one of the top 'wonders of the world' and often referred to as the Garden of Eden. This volcanic area is home to a diversity of ecosystems and an abundant wildlife with the exception of giraffe due to the steep descent. We will be back at the lodge for freshening up and lunch before our last journey to Arusha and your return flight. Safiri salama!
