The annual Rhino Charge is a fund raising event organised by Rhino Ark for the protection of Kenyan mountain forests, also known as the water towers, as they are the main catchments of all main rivers in the country.

Rhino Ark was formed back in 1988 at the time when Kenya's rhino was severely under threat from poaching. Its aim was to build a fence around the Aberdare conservation area comprising the Aberdares National Park and the surrounding forest. This fence is now completed and helps protect wildlife from poaching but also prevent game from marauding at night into the farms neighbouring the conservation area destroying crops creating fear and loss of revenue. It therefore contributes to resolving human/wildlife conflict. The fence also aims at curb other illegal activities including log extraction and charcoal production. The fence is now 400 kilometres long! The prime fundraiser has been the now famous off road annual Rhino Charge. A restricted number of entries totalling 65 four wheel drives tackle impossible terrain to complete the shortest distance between thirteen 'guard posts' by travelling in a straight a line as is feasible. To enter the event, teams from Kenya and overseas have to raise as much money as they can for the sponsorship of this cause.

Based on the successes of the Aberdare Fence and following the need to address the challenges in other key water towers of Kenya, Rhino Ark committed to protect Mt. Kenya and Mt. Eburu, in addition to its ongoing conservation commitments to the Aberdare Mountains. At centre of Rhino Ark's conservation interventions in these two mountains is the building and maintenance game-proof electric fences, such as the completed 400 km long Aberdare Electric Fence.

On 7 September 2012, the Mt. Kenya Electric fence was launched by Hon. Njeru Githae, Minister for Finance. To-date, 165 km of the fence has been built which, once completed, will be 450 km long and will protect over 2,500 sq. km of prime forests with rich biodiversity and critical catchment areas. In the Mau Forests Complex, the 43.3 perimeter electric fence around Mt. Eburu was completed in November 2014 and Rhino Ark is now preparing to fence South Western Mau Forest Reserve.

But the conservation portfolio of Rhino Ark goes well beyond fencing and also includes building capacity of KFS and KWS in fence management, combating wildlife crime and responding to wildfires; supporting community-based patrols; ecological monitoring; aerial surveillance; environmental education; promotion of bio-enterprise development; and securing wildlife corridors.
