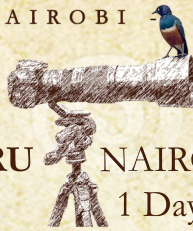

(i) KIFARU NAIROBI NATIONAL PARK 1 Day Safari

Nairobi National Park, on the doorstep of Nairobi, the capital city of Kenya and one of the fastest growing cities in Africa, is a unique game park within an urban center covering some 115km². The park has a variety of ecosystems ranging from woodland to steep gorges and streams as well as typical African savannah dotted with acacia trees. It hosts a diversity of flora and fauna. Its wildlife includes antelope, zebra, giraffe, buffalo, rhino and lion to name a few. Its bird life is also abundant and you can spot up to 500 species of birds making it very attractive for the keen ontologists. Today, progress and SGR, the new Standard Gauge Railway, as well as the ever increasing human population is threatening its very survival.

Red Lands Roses, located some 35km North East of Nairobi, in Ruiru specialises in growing T-Hybrid and spray roses in a range of over 100 varieties. These roses are grown in 28 hectares of greenhouses on a 100% hydroponic system with full recycling of water, preventing rejects of phosphates and nitrates in ground water. Red Lands Roses is internationally recognized for its green horticulture that respects people and the environment.

Kiambu Tea Farm, set in beautiful gardens in an indigenous forest, is a four generation settlers farm located on the outskirts of Nairobi in Limuru.

Giraffe Manor located in a suburb of Nairobi, Langata, is among Nairobi's most iconic buildings from the 30s. It is set in lush gardens with elegant interiors dedicated to its resident host, the Rothschild's giraffes who may pop their heads through the windows to share breakfast.

Karen Blixen Museum was once the home of Karen Blixen, Danish author who inspired the making of the film 'Out of Africa' and her husband Baron Bror von Blixen Fincke.
