The annual Rhino Charge, organized by Rhino Ark, is a fundraising event aimed at protecting Kenya's mountain forests, often referred to as the country's "water towers" due to their role as primary river catchments. Rhino Ark was established in 1988 in response to the severe poaching threat faced by Kenya's rhinos. Its initial goal was to construct a fence around the Aberdare conservation area, which includes Aberdare National Park and its surrounding forests. This fence has been completed and not only protects wildlife from poaching but also prevents animals from entering neighboring farms at night, which helps reduce crop destruction and associated economic losses. It plays a crucial role in mitigating human-wildlife conflict and curbing illegal activities like logging and charcoal production. The fence stretches 400 kilometers!

The highlight of the fundraising efforts is the renowned off-road Rhino Charge, where a limited number of 65 four-wheel-drive vehicles navigate challenging terrain to travel the shortest possible distance between thirteen 'guard posts.' Teams from Kenya and abroad participate by raising funds to support this initiative.

Building on the success of the Aberdare Fence and addressing challenges in other vital water towers, Rhino Ark has also committed to protecting Mt. Kenya and Mt. Eburu alongside its ongoing work in the Aberdare Mountains. Central to these conservation efforts is the construction and maintenance of game-proof electric fences, similar to the completed Aberdare Electric Fence.

Beyond fencing, Rhino Ark's conservation efforts include enhancing the capabilities of the Kenya Forest Service and Kenya Wildlife Service in fence management, combating wildlife crime, wildfire response, supporting community patrols, ecological monitoring, aerial surveillance, environmental education, promoting bio-enterprise development, and securing wildlife corridors.

We offer two types of accommodation:

LAF Fly Camp:

This consist of igloo type tents kitted with cot beds, mattress and linen.

You are to share communal shower and toilets.

LAF Traditional Mobile Camp:

This is a traditional, comfortable, eco-friendly mobile tented camp. It consists of large spacious walk-in-tents fully kitted with either double or twin beds, linen, towels, side tables, solar lamp, rags and table & chair, and on the veranda, safari chairs, hand basin, mirror. Hot 'bush shower and 'short drop' toilet at the rear of each unit. Hurricane lantern both in front and at the rear of each unit.

Both camps share a common area and open mess for meals.

Meals consist of full English breakfast, buffet lunch and a three course dinner prepared by our highly skilled chef and impeccably presented, served in a semi open mess. Our well stocked bar, tea and coffee are available at all times

There are facilities in the mess for charging phones and laptops only. Please check with the camp manager times when the generator is on.
